The Bowling Tech Mission

The mission of Bowling Tech is to train AMF Bowling center management and technical staff in safe and cost-effective maintenance procedures which will help to improve your centers machine operation and reduce costs.

All Bowling Tech classes are held in active AMF chain bowling centers located throughout the United States, this brings the school closer to the student thereby reducing the cost to the student.

Active bowling centers give the students "real world" experience. Active bowling centers require the lanes for business every evening so this gives the students the "real world" pressure to perform. The machines we work on have the usual wear and tear of 25-40 years of use. The skills required to trouble shoot and repair machine problems typically found on these machines are developed or improved.

The students are paired, usually placing a more experienced mechanic with a newer mechanic. This helps improve the training process and skill sharing.

The training is divided between the classroom 20%, and hands-on in the machines 80%.

Class Size

- A minimum of 8 students is required to hold the class, the class may be cancelled if the minimum is not met, and students who have registered and paid will be rescheduled for the next available class. Maximum class size is 16 students.

Recommended experience

- This is not a course for beginners; basic training should be handled at the center level.
- **STUDENTS MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE.**
- All students should have at least 6 months of experience prior to attending; exceptions will be made on a case by case basis.

Tuition and travel expenses

- Tuition for the 2 week course is \$1,995.00; payable by company check, Visa, MasterCard, AMEX, or the IMPAC card from the military.
- Group rates are available, call for details.
- Tuition is due 3 weeks prior to the class starting date.
- Cost of tuition is subject to change; we have kept the cost the same for the last 3 years.
- All travel arrangements, meals, hotel, and travel related expenses are the responsibility of the student.
- AMF *does not* provide transportation to and from the hosting center location, airports, bus or train stations.

Class Duration

- **2 weeks, Monday through Friday, no weekends, classes are held in various locations throughout the United States. It is possible to attend the first week at one location and the second week at a different location.**

- **11:30 to 12:30 lunch hour**
- **12:30 to 5:00 machine work**

Grading

Students are graded in several categories that include but are not limited to.

- Safety
- Attendance
- Theory / Sequences
- Machine work logs
- Parts usage logs
- Homework-Parts Identification
- Machine work; repairs, troubleshooting and adjustments
- Class participation, teamwork, following instruction
- Preventive Maintenance; cleaning, lubrication, and administration
- Test grades

These grades are averaged for a final grade.

- 85% is considered a passing grade
- A certificate of completion will be issued to all students that pass the course.
